- 10:30 a.m. – 12:00 pm** **Mystic Mountain activities**

The Coyaba River Garden and Museum is an indoor/outdoor facility that mainly focuses on native Taino Indians and Spanish settlers. Inside, guests will find a collection of artefacts that detail the life and culture of the original inhabitants of Jamaica. Outside is a spectacular courtyard featuring a decorative fountain and innumerable tropical plants. They also feature a lookout point with views of the harbour.
